THAT'S MY GAL raced up inside after the break while lugged out, was pushed to the lead on the turn but had nothing left once in the stretch and lost her rider at the wire.

JIMMYTHISNJIMTHAT broke awkwardly and the rider lost his left iron, took a furlong to regain his footing then drifted inward and caused some traffic issues leaving the half mile pole, was four wide to the stretch then tired in mid stretch. SIERRA DANCE tracked the pace to the turn, came two wide to the stretch then lacked the needed late response. TIZ PROOF was chasing the pace, was forced to check in tight nearing the seven sixteenths then gave way in the stretch.
