ACCELERATO prompted the pace for a half mile, was outkicked three wide on the second turn but kept to task, closed fast but was too late. VIRGHAZI had no speed, trailed to the second turn, circled four wide to the stretch while being outrun by the winner but also closed ground while being outfinished by the top two. THE BOLD ONE chased the winner to the second turn, was two wide to the stretch then closed a gap without threatening. MOJOLICIOUS pressed the pace for five furlongs, saved ground but gave way in the drive.

ZUCCHINI tracked the leaders from off the rail to mid turn, split foes two wide into the lane to gain command a furlong out, dueled to the line and held gamely. DETANGLER lagged early, moved quickly from the rail on the turn, challenged a furlong out but lost his punch. KING OF LEON (ARG) rushed up from the rail to duel early for the lead, edged clear on the turn but slackened in the lane.
