BEAUTY OF AUTISM was settled for a half mile, tried to make a run while circling four wide on the second turn but could not impact the winner while not threatened for second. HAVING FUN got outsprinted early, was two wide throughout but was not a factor. DEL MAR DIVA pressed the winner three wide for six furlongs then gave way. LITTLE MISS HOTTIE was also prompting inside of DEL MAR DIVA to the second turn but stopped after six furlongs.
