NEVER MIZZ settled early, moved up four wide to the stretch and finished steadily. SENECA SALLY dueled two wide into the stretch and gave way. INEEDAMANIANDAPEDI broke poorly and was unhurried early, raced two wide on the turn but did not rally. SWAYBELLE rushed up from the inside to duel for the lead to the head of the lane and had little left. I'M PATRIOTIC had no speed.
