MILADY MAID stalked the winner to the turn, was four wide while being outrun to the stretch and came up empty in the drive. COURTING MISCHIEF pressed the winner from the rail to the stretch then gave way.

ITSSHERPREROGATIVE got outsprinted early, tried to bid three wide but weakened in the drive. ELINDA showed little.
