CRIMSON CLOUD was permitted to settle while three wide early, commenced his bid midway on the second turn while four wide to rally steadily and won driving. WARRENS GOLDNUGGET stalked the pace from the off the rail throughout, forged to the front in the upper stretch but could not hold the winner. CONSTANT CRAVING set all of the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and slackened. DEANNS MOJAVE raced unhurried while three wide to the backstretch, got caught in tight quarters behind WARRENS GOLDNUGGET on the second turn and waited briefly then lacked the needed response. TRICKED AGAIN lagged early, was three wide on both turns and failed to rally.
