BLACK SONA pressed the pace to the half, was forced out to the five path by the loose horse on the second turn, rallied but was handled cautiously inside the unaccompanied steed then was forced to take up sharply a sixteenth out when AWE lugged inward but was comfortably in front by then. ITALIAN FLING set a pressured pace while always aware of the loose horse, was forced four wide on the second turn then got outkicked to mid stretch but was never threatened for second. POST ROCK chased the top two to the second turn then was outrun while saving ground to the stretch and gave way. PIRATE SHIP was fanned five deep to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, tired after six furlongs and stopped in the stretch. AWE stumbled at the start and unseated his rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start of the race but did not alter the results.
